

Moor View Lodges - Holly Lodge

Holly Lodge is currently part of our own letting fleet. It is being sold for private holiday use, and would probably suit a buyer who is looking for a comfortable, high quality holiday lodge. Holly Lodge is the largest lodge on our park, and could be an investment if you are looking for a holiday property that allows you to own a holiday home for the times you want to use it, and then simply let the lodge for holiday lettings whenever you aren't using it. This could cover the overhead costs of your holiday home, and provided an income as a return on the investment. Holly Lodge has exceptional occupancy levels as an extremely popular holiday lodge due to its size, quality and layout. (It would be up to the new owners of Holly Lodge to decide whether they continued to let Holly Lodge or just use it for their own private use.) :-

Frequently asked questions

Can I live here permanently?

Holly Lodge is a holiday lodge and owners must have another address as their residential address.

How long is the license?

Holly Lodge is being sold with an 85 year license.

What are the running costs?

- Holly Lodge : £2200.00 per annum + VAT, with an annual increase linked to RPI.
- Business Rates and refuse: Around £60.00 per qtr.
- LPG Gas: LPG Gas is piped to each lodge and is metered; therefore the cost would be representative of usage.
- Electricity: Again this is metered, and therefore the cost would be representative of usage.
- General Maintenance: An owner would need to allow for the lodge to have the protective coating reapplied (painted) approximately every three years.

How do I let the holiday lodge?

If you chose to let your lodge, the Lodge can be let through Moor View Lodges, our letting agency. Further details of this and a copy of the letting agreement are available on request.
